Program introduction

Living Gestalt in Organizations is an invitation for Gestalt practitioners to revive, expand, and strengthen their identity within the organizational field.

This 2.5-month intensive version of the program offers a focused space for integration of Gestalt theory, identity, and practice — bridging therapeutic and organizational experience in a highly experiential format.

Through a combination of online workshops, supervision, and work on real cases, participants develop authentic presence and their own Gestalt style — distinct yet flexible, adaptable to the dynamic contexts of organizations.

Who the program is for

For Gestalt therapists and practitioners who:

have completed Gestalt therapy training (4 years) or Gestalt Coaching/OD training of at least 120 hours;

have sense of identity as organisational practitioners

have at minimum 5 years of experience in or with organizations as managers, Human Resources professionals, consultants, trainers, coaches, facilitators, managers or entrepreneurs;

already experience and wish to deepen their understanding of Gestalt application in organizational settings, grounded in the tradition of process and Gestalt consulting;

want to strengthen and articulate their Gestalt identity in professional practice.

Admission requirements:

A clear letter of intent and an introductory individual interview.

How this program stands out

Living Gestalt in Organizations – Short Intensive Program (GPO) is unique in the region and beyond because:

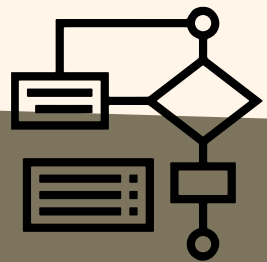
- It is designed exclusively for experienced Gestalt practitioners — not as an introductory training, but as a deepening and integrative experience.
- It combines experiential learning, practical application, and professional supervision in a compact 2.5-month format.
- It meets the EAGT criteria for applying for Gestalt Practitioners in Organisation (GPO) membership and status and undergoing international certification process for GPO
- Participants are experienced professionals from diverse organizational backgrounds.
- Conducted in a small, international group (maximum 12 participants) with a high level of personal contact and supervision support.

Program structure

Schedule - 3 modules (6 half-a-day workshops)

Each workshop is delivered online as a **half-day session (4 hours), held on Thursdays and Fridays, 16:00–20:00 CET.**

Between modules, participants engage in individual and group supervision, as well as peer learning activities.

Supervision:

3 group supervisions (3h each)
smaller groups (up to 6 participants) working on
real-life cases, scheduled between modules in
afternoon hours

Individual supervision

(6h per participant) – required for
certification, arranged
individually during the program

Peer activities and support:

Biweekly peer group work, minimum 3 hours per month on seminar themes.

Depending on the group composition, the program will be held in Croatian and/or English.

Tuition and fees

Regular fee: **2500 €**

Early bird: **2250 €** (for applications before November 30th)

Payment possible in
4 instalments

Introductory interview (50 minutes): 80 €

If the participant joins the program, the amount is deducted
from the total fee.

The fee includes:

- all workshops, group and individual supervisions,
- learning materials and templates,
- final certificate: **“Living Gestalt in Organizations – 40h CPD”**
- Support in **EAGT GPO certification process**



Certification

The program meets the **EAGT criteria for Continuing Professional Development (CPD)** and includes 40 hours of structured experiential learning and supervision.

Participants receive a certificate of completion: **“Living Gestalt in Organizations – Short Intensive GPO Program – 40h CPD.”**

Why now

Across Europe, Gestalt training has expanded significantly. Many practitioners in organisations with Gestalt background are now seeking the next step — a space for **integration, application** and deepening of their Gestalt organisational **identity**.

This program responds to that need: to keep Gestalt alive, in **contact** with organizations, people and systems we are part of.
